

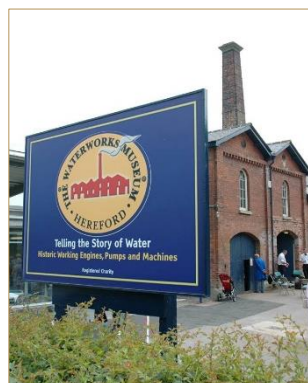

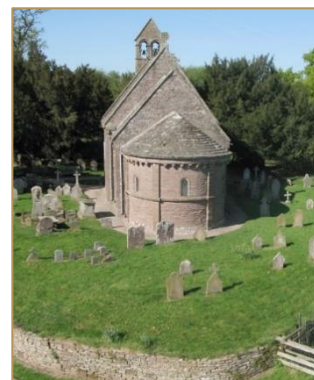
Hereford Cider Museum
